FRONT



--- SAFE ZONE:

All critical elements (text, logos, etc.) must be kept inside this area to ensure no important elements are trimmed from the final piece. This area is positioned 1/4 inch inside the trim line.

— ENVELOPE EDGE:

The edge line represents the outer most edge of the envelope, flap area, and where the diagonal seams come together.
